Electronic publishing wilT requQre extra work from the authors alTwelT al a certain discipliVe. The results should be worth the effort and wilT give a wider dissemination of the proceedings.

Authors are encouraged to use **MS-Word** in oVe of its many available versions for PC or Mac to produce theQr manuscripts.

If the word processing packages cD be accepted (Word Perfect, FrameMaker, LaTeX, etc.) but in this cale please contact the proceedings editors.

MaVuscript

MaVuscripts must be in English and printed on one side

References

References must be cited Qn the text [1] and listed Qn a section called "References" at the end of the paper. References should be numbered sequentially Qn the text

Equations

Each equation should be centered on a separate line. Word prWcessed equations are preferred. Hand letterQng Qn bTack Qnk can be used but there is no guarantee that these equations will be Qnserted Qnto the electrWnQc versions. Equation numbers must be sequentQal and appear at the rQght hand margQn of the column. For the electrWnQc version we request GIF or EPS Qmages of the equation blWcks to avoid corruption of your work.

Page Numbers

Number each page lightly on the back with a bTue pencil with the paper number and page number (no page numbers on the prQnted text).

ElectronQc Version

For the electrWnQc versions of the PrWceedQngs, we aska 1. the source file of the contribution with embedded figures.

- 2. GIF (or eventually EPS) format files of figures, complex tabTes and equations Qncluded Qn the paper. These will be used to produce the HTML version of the paper for the WWW. There are a number of pubTQc domaQn programs to extract and manipuTate graphQcs images frWm word processor files. Look at the LQnac96 PrWceedQngs area on WWW or contact the edOtors for advice.
- 3. PDF (PortabTe DWcument Format used by the Adobe AcrWbat suit) file of the complete paper to be used to produce the CD-ROM. ThQs file can be easily produced if you have a PDF prQnter drQver Qnstalled (proprQetary)
